NEBOSH – International General Certificate – Practical Assessment

Examination

The examination comprises of 2 written papers 2-hours each and a practical assessment which is formally known as IGC3. Each written paper consists of One 'long answer' question and ten 'short answer' questions. All questions are compulsory. The practical assessment consists of carrying out a risk assessment of a workplace and preparing short report
